

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Rabun County *Water System*

Our Community Water System (CWS) violated drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. We did not properly complete the required monitoring or testing for **DISINFECTION BY-PRODUCTS (TTHMs & HAA5s) during the **1/01/2024 – 03/31/2024** compliance period and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.**

What should You do? There is nothing you need to do at this time.
